Upon receipt of the application you will be contacted by members of the CCAST membership committee to set up a studio visit to meet you and see your work LIVE!

There will be a one-time Studio Tour website setup fee of \$60, plus the yearly Studio Tour member fee of \$150 when you are invited to join the tour.
